Housing Authority of the City of New Brunswick (MID-L-1393-20) & New Brunswick Apartments v. Deborah Jimenez (MID-L-1974-21), Superior Court of New Jersey, Middlesex County, Law Division

WHEREAS, there is currently pending in the Superior Court of New Jersey consolidated civil actions entitled <u>Deborah Jimenez v. Housing Authority of the City of New Brunswick</u>, Docket No. MID-L-1393-20, and <u>New Brunswick Apartments v. Deborah Jimenez</u>, Docket No. MID-L-1393-20 (the "Litigation"); and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of New Brunswick's (the "Housing Authority") outside defense counsel, DeCotiis, FitzPatrick, Cole & Giblin, LLP, has completed written and deposition discovery with respect to the Litigation; and

WHEREAS, after conducting discovery, the parties in the consolidated Litigation reached a tentative global settlement, whereby the Housing Authority has agreed to settle all claims and costs in the amount of \$15,000; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority's outside defense counsel is in agreement with the terms of the proposed settlement and believes that it would be in the best interest of the Housing Authority to settle the Litigation, in accordance with the terms as set forth above, to avoid further defense costs and uncertainty of further litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority's has certified that the settlement sum is available to effectuate this settlement.

### NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF NEW BRUNSWICK:

The Housing Authority hereby approves and authorizes payment in the amount of \$15,000 toward the settlement amount, with a certain portion of which to be covered by and through the Housing Authority's insurance carrier, the New Jersey Public Housing Authority Joint Insured Fund, in full and final resolution of the cosolidated Litigation, in exchange for a Stipulation of Dismissal With Prejudice on behalf of the Housing Authority of the City of New Brunswick.
